Another major task John accomplished was de-coupling access information from the HNG Administration Guide to create the RAN Administration Guide. He improved content, aligned organization and feature naming with the PLM Supported Feature Lists, and added RAN-specific overviews consistent with marketing information. In addition, he became lead writer for 2G and 3G functionality, and was ramping up to take over 4G.

Finally, John took a deeper look at the Software Installation and Upgrade Guide and began the process of improving this document. He worked with our PW EMS and HNG leads to help split out responsibility for their areas of expertise and to better communicate with Engineering teams.

In short, John could handle whatever was thrown his way and was absolutely my go-to guy. Any group would be lucky to have him as a member.
